PLEASE NOTE:

Film footage donated by CBS is divided into two categories: Exhibit A and Exhibit B.

When making copies of film footage listed in Exhibit A, the Library must "edit out" all CBS personalities, i.e., Walter Cronkite.

Additional clearances are required for the Martin Luther King, "I Have a Dream" speech of August 28, 1963 and the poetry recital of Robert Frost at the Inauguration on January 20, 1961.

Prior to the Foundation granting permission to use either film footage, an individual must first contact Intellectual Properties Management for the Martin Luther King, "I Have a Dream" speech and Peter Gilbert (The Vermont Council on the Humanities) for the poetry recital of Robert Frost at the Inauguration, for their permission and then provide copies of said permission to the Foundation.

Footage in Exhibit B is available for research purposes only and may not be licensed.

Per the deed from CBS, the John F. Kennedy Presidential Library and Museum and the John F. Kennedy Library Foundation are prohibited from making copies of any film footage listed in Exhibit B. Researchers are, however, allowed to view Exhibit B film footage at the Library.
