believe that only God can give strength and wisdom to face the future.

Enclosed you will find a mourning card we wanted to send to you and your husband around the time the tragedy occurred. However, I felt that later would be a better time.

Isn't it strange how people with so much to give to the world are taken? That's God's will however and not for us to question.

We pray some ultimate result will grow out of the investigation in to your husband's death. I can't say that any amount of assurance can be given us that an arrest or a conviction will come to pass

in the death of our Children
