Overview

This year the Kennedy Library will recognize 100 middle school students for the difference they have made in their communities through service projects. Principals, teachers, and counselors in Massachusetts middle schools are encouraged to identify up to two students per middle school for this award.

Eligibility

All middle school students (grades 6-8) participating in unique community service projects are eligible. School personnel should give special consideration to students who have distinguished themselves through their creative service work. Awards will be given to the first 100 names submitted. (Please note that previous award winners are not eligible.)

Deadline

All submissions must be received by April 30, 2021. The first 100 students identified will receive a confirmation email with a digital copy of the certificate and information about the virtual program highlighting their accomplishments. Award Recognition

The 2021 Virtual Award Recognition Program will take place in early June. More information about this program will be sent to the students, educators, and parents in May. In addition, each Award winner will receive a personalized *Make a Difference Award* certificate in recognition of their service project.


